

2018 Iowa Limousin Association Sale

General Rules

ALL CONSIGNORS must be paid members of the Iowa Limousin Association for 2018 @ \$50 per year.

ENTRY DEADLINE is December 10, 2017 entry fee is \$200, this includes all the bedding fees. Wood chips for both barn and tieout bedding is provided. (\$100 entry, \$100 refunded if animal or substitution goes through the sale.)

Embryo packages of 3, \$100, please read below.

No substitution fee. No Refunds. **Current performance paper and information, entry form and entry fee constitutes a complete entry or email to Ann. Following the sale cattle will be transferred electronically.**

Cattle need to be registered prior to entry. Herd prefix, individual tattoos and sex must be included at entry as well as footnotes(not to exceed 140 characters including spaces and punctuations.)

PICTURES **Catalog photos (emailed, due 1/1)are FREE. We may do a color catalog so remember that for you're your photos.** GOOD PICTURES DO HELP SELL YOUR CATTLE.

All catalog information including pedigree, performance and EPDs will be obtained from the NALF website.

BULL WEIGHTS, TATTOOS CHECKED, MEASUREMENTS & ULTRASOUND will be taken at the check-in chute, and tagged with IBE tag

****New- a floor price will be established by the all consignors prior to the sale time. All cattle that go through the sale ring will be assessed commission at the ILA established rate.**

All Limousin & Lim-Flex cattle sold in the IBE Limousin Sale are guaranteed by the breeder to be free of Arthrogyrosis (AM or Curly Calf Syndrome) and Neuropathic Hydrocephalus (NH or Waterhead), known lethal genetic defects found in Angus and Angus based cattle and Osteopetrosis (OS or marble bone disease) a genetic defect in Red Angus and Red Angus Based cattle. All animals are guaranteed by the breeder to be free either by pedigree or by genotype from an accredited lab if they are potential carriers. All animals are guaranteed by the consignor to be breeders as defined by the NALF sanctioned guidelines.

*****New- A negative trich-test is required on all non-virgin Limousin bulls and all bulls born prior to Jan. 1,2017, check with your vet early. Bulls will be ultrasound scanned for ribeye area and fat thickness with results published.**

All bulls brought to the Expo site must have a nose-lead in place. This nose-lead, with strap attached must be on the bull whenever he is handled during unloading, grooming, showing, selling, loading, etc., the nose-lead will go with the bull when sold. This is an Expo rule for all breeds. VIOLATIONS will result in EXPULSION

Females of any age are eligible to sell and must carry a calfhood vaccination tattoo. Bred females must be bred to a registered Limousin or Lim-Flex bull and calve by 30 months of age. Females over 30 months of age may sell only with a natural suckling calf under 270 days of age at side.

Embryos packages of 3 or more may sell . Embryos can be represented at the sale by either parent or sibling to the embryo being offered for sale. (entry fee for embryo packages will be \$100 or \$200 if you want to represent them with a parent or sibling) Pregnant recipients must be available sale day with a current health paper or seller pays delivery.

All consignments are screened at the expo by the ILA Sale Selection Committee.

Purebred--Lim-Flex

Purebred Limousin (orange registration papers) Lim-Flex (purple registration papers). We will have a video parade on Tuesday, February 13 at 11 am for sure. Cattle are catalogued by age not Purebred or Lim-Flex.

I will email you after entries are in as to if we have a show or just a video parade. If we have a show, how it will be established.

All animals must have legible tattoos that correspond to their registration paper. Tattoos will be checked on site.

Health Requirements

- i A sample health paper from Iowa Expo Vets with expo tests will be sent to all consignors Jan. 1 after entries have been received. **Tests after 1/20/18.**
 - i **Bulls must have a lead in place at all times.** A negative trich-test will be required on all non-virgin Limousin bulls.
 - i All bulls born before Jan. 1, 2017 must pass a breeding soundness exam and/or semen evaluation & physical exam and have a negative trich test performed by a licensed vet after January 20, and noted on their health certificate.
 - i All cattle must be identified with breed tattoo AND registration# AND USDA metal tag or USDA Brucellosis tag on health paper. Females must have a calfhood tattoo/shield to sell.
